A Rotarian, dressed as Santa Claus, along with his Merry Elves, will visit their homes to deliver toys, clothes, linens and other necessities such as toothbrushes, blankets, hair cuts and Christmas dinner. Without Rotary Santa, many of these families would not have a Christmas.
